Kaden is 15 years old and lives with his family in Bedford County. He is deaf and nonverbal and has Autism and an intellectual disability. Kaden also has challenges with his heart and a shunt in his head to relieve the pressure of fluid on his brain. His Elks Home Service Nurse is Carol Przybocki. She met Kaden and his family when they moved to Pennsylvania from another state three years ago. She helped them get donated diapers until they could find and get registered with a new supplier. Here is a picture of Kaden in the medical stroller and car seat that Carol helped them obtain. Kaden's mother says the car seat is "Amazing"! His family can now safely take him anywhere he needs to go.

Here is a note from Kaden's mom:

Carol is the best nurse I've ever had since I moved to PA. She helped me find a wheelchair stroller for my son and a special needs car seat for my son off of Facebook website that she told me to go and check out. She has brought me and my family food. She's always there when I need her. Just such a most amazing person I have ever come in contact with. I could never ask for a better person Carol to have in my life and my family's life. She is at once again an awesome and amazing person.
