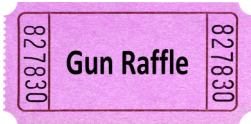

The House Committee is also reviewing online food ordering options along with curbside pickup as we continuously work at providing good food

and value for our members during these challenging times.

This St. Patty's Day our Lodge will open at 11am with the kitchen having food available starting at 1130am. Come early and treat yourself to a traditional Reuben sandwich! Starting at 4pm, Corned Beef and Cabbage will also be available.
